

## Garden Funding Resources



There are many different options to secure funding for a garden. Take advantage of these on-going fund raising opportunities, online fundraising platforms, and grants available for school projects.

[Whole Kids Foundation](#) is accepting grant applications through November of each year. Whole Kids Foundation has donated about 1.7 million dollars to almost nine hundred schools who have applied for their garden grant.

[Lowe's Toolbox for Education](#) has an ongoing application process dedicated to giving funds to school gardens.

[Woolley School Garden](#) offers an online platform to submit your school into a fundraising program. Using your school's link, anyone can donate a minimum of five dollars toward your cause. This creates a more convenient way to donate.

[Captain Planet Foundation](#) offers between 250 and 2,500 dollars for school environmental projects, such as planting a garden. Their application process is open until February and September.

[Environmental Protection Agency](#) offers environmental education grants until December.

[Kids Gardening](#) has an application process funded by Home Depot that ends in December. It also provides great examples and information about the planning process to serve as an additional resource.

[Project Learning Tree's](#) GreenWorks! environmental education grant is open until September.

[Annie's](#) Garden Grant has funded over 250 gardens, and the applications are due in December.

[Do Something](#) offers \$500 seed grants every week.

[Donor's Choose](#) is an online platform for teachers to create a "giving page" for their cause. This might take a bit of effort and technical skill level, but would be easy to e-mail parents a link. Donations would be a click away on a secure platform.
